Mission Statement

Parkview Christian School exists to partner with parents in moving students toward their God given potential through Biblical instruction, character accountability, challenging curriculum and appropriate co-curricular opportunities. History and Leadership

Parkview Christian School was founded in 1980 by Pastor Carl Godwin. It began with 67 students and 8 staff members. Since then we have grown to nearly 150 students in our Preschool through 12th grade. We have also added three child development centers with a combined enrollment of 250 children.

The Parkview Christian Secondary School is located in the main building at 4400 N 1st St. We are currently raising funds to build a new school on the property located on 1st Street next to the current school. God is moving Parkview in amazing ways! Please continue to pray for us.

Statement of Faith

Parkview Christian School is a non-denominational Christian, academic institution. We offer families the opportunity to have their children educated from a Christian worldview and nurtured in an environment that promotes prayer and daily devotion with Christ. While we do not require students to adhere to a certain faith, we do teach from the Bible. The following is our statement of faith:

- 1. We believe the Scripture of the Old and New Testament are verbally inspired by God and inerrant in the original writing, and that they are of supreme and final authority in faith and life.
- 2. We believe in one God, eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- 3. We believe that Jesus Christ was begotten by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary and is true God and true man.
- 4. We believe that man was created in the image of God; that man sinned and thereby, incurred not only physical death but also spiritual death which is eternal separation from God; and that all human beings are born with a sinful nature and, in the case of those who reach moral responsibility, manifest themselves as sinners.
- 5. We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins, as a substitutionary sacrifice; in order to reconcile us to a right relationship with God, and that all who believe in Him are justified on the grounds of His shed blood.
- 6. We believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of our Lord, in His ascension into Heaven, and in His present life there for us, as High Priest and Advocate.
- 7. We believe in "that blessed hope,"-the personal, pretribulational, and imminent return of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
- 8. We believe that all who receive by faith the Lord Jesus Christ are born again of the Holy Spirit and thereby, become children of God.
- 9. We believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust, the everlasting blessedness to the saved, and the everlasting punishment of the lost.
- 10. We believe in the separation of church and state with each having definite and distinct spheres of responsibility.



Academics

Parkview is proud to support our curriculum with A Beka education materials. Our students learn a variety of subjects from a Christian perspective. We hold high academic standards in our core subjects and many elective and special classes. We offer courses in Fine Arts, Technology, Business, Career and College Planning, and Weight Training. All of our students are required to attend Bible class each day- even in our elementary school!





Fine Arts

We love drama at Parkview...and choir, band, art, speech, and Poetry Out Loud! Our students enjoy participating in these activities. Students are encouraged to take courses during the school day and also compete in activities after school. Parkview is the only Class D school in Nebraska which offers Orchestra. Our elementary students also have the advantage of daily Band and Choir during the school day. Their enthusiasm at the Christmas and Easter programs is always a joy to behold!



Athletics

Parkview Christian School is a D2 School. We offer Football, Volleyball, Cheerleading, Boys & Girls Basketball, and Boys & Girls Track. Our Middle School offers the same sports as High School and even allows 6th graders to compete on some of the teams.

Our recent accolades including winning the 2015 D2 Track Championship. The team went on to finish eighth overall at the State Track Meet. Our basketball team has also had recent success. The boys have been Frontier Conference regular season champions for four years in a row and Frontier Conference tournament champions three years in a row.

Students transferring from other schools will need to meet the NSAA deadline for participation in Activities. All students competing in athletics will need to complete an NSAA form and have a sports physical completed before participating.

Financial Aid Program

Parkview is passionate about keeping our school affordable so more families can provide their children with a faith-based education. One way we help families in this effort is to offer a Financial Aid Program to those who qualify. Our Financial Aid Program is needs based. If your family is interested in applying the following information is helpful in understanding the procedures.

Process (Refer to Admissions Checklist)

- 1. A family must have completed all enrollment paperwork, including submitting immunizations, birth certificate, transfer records, and enrollment fees. When submitting the tuition agreement into the office please select the option to apply for Financial Aid.
- 2. Upon receiving your paperwork and the tuition agreement, select the Financial Aid option, and the office will contact you to schedule a meeting
- 3. Prior to the meeting, the family must complete a letter of intent and a Grant & Aid Application on www.factstuitionaid.com
- 4. The Financial Aid Committee and family will meet and discuss eligibility and expectations
- 5. The Committee will send the family an offer letter if they meet the scholarship requirements.

Eligibility for Aid

- 1. All students must conclude each semester with a 2.0.
- 2. A student on financial aid may not fail any one class at a semester break.
- 3. A student receiving financial aid can not exceed 10 unexcused absences a semester
- 4. All families receiving financial aid must attend 100% of scheduled parent teacher conferences unless previously approved by the administration

5. All families receiving financial aid must volunteer a minimum of 10 hours throughout the school year.
